Hello, Etz Chaim Family.

A guick look back at two January events:

Our congregation had a strong showing at the January 19th "Prayers of the Community" interfaith service at United Methodist Church. Pastor Ella appreciated that so many of us came to the service in support and care for one another. We sang the prayer for healing Mi Shebeirach (with help from a Debbie Friedman recording), and Rich Kleitman did a beautiful reading of the URJ's A Prayer for Shabbat Tzedek (Shabbat of

Justice) at the podium.

Two days later, a small but enthusiastic group carried our Etz Chaim banner in the Martin Luther King Jr. march from Amtrak to the Merced Theatre. We were directly in front of the middle school band, so it was an enjoyable, music-filled walk. I hope we number a dozen at next year's march.



What's coming in February in addition to our formal Shabbat service (Feb. 7), and potluck followed by lay-led service (Feb. 21): A seder? Yes, a seder!

When you hear the word "seder," the first thing that comes to mind is probably Passover or Pesach. But the holiday Tu B'Shvat, (literally the



"15th of Shvat") is a celebration of the New Year of the Trees. and also involves a seder. Ours will be on Saturday, February 15th, followed by a potluck dinner. The word Seder means "order", so during our celebration the food is identified and eaten in a specific order. Since this holiday celebrates nature and the environment, the seder food includes


fruit and nuts – traditionally, pomegranate, grapes, dates, figs, olives, wheat, and barley, representing the seven species described in Deuteronomy 8:8. Come hungry.
